We are used to hearing the media hype about the latest techniques, serums, and celebrities having cosmetic surgery; however, there are equally important and exciting reconstructive surgery options you should know about that may help you live a more fulfilling and optimal life. The most common reconstructive surgeries are skin cancer revision and nose surgery. And in some cases, a combination of reconstructive and cosmetic surgery achieves maximum results.

#### **Cancer Reconstruction**

Most skin cancer reconstruction is performed at the time of the cancer removal. If the area is small, the wound may be closed by bringing the edges of the skin together. Another option is to use a local skin flap. A portion of nearby skin, tissue, and blood supply is repositioned over the wound. For larger wounds, a skin graft may be needed to cover the area. Skin grafts are taken from another part of the body, such as the neck or leg. With complicated or

extensive cancer, reconstruction may be delayed until the pathologist can confirm that the tumor has been completely removed.

### Nasal Reconstruction

A functional rhinoplasty, or nasal reconstruction, may be required to alleviate obstruction to the nasal airways. The obstruction may be caused by a deviated septum, polyp, tumor, or weakened nasal tissue. When someone has a deviated septum, the wall between the two sides of the nose is crooked; this can obstruct the flow of air through the nose. Side effects may include headaches, persistent nosebleeds, and sinusitis. The crooked portions of the septum may be trimmed, straightened, augmented, or removed. Polyps and tumors are surgically removed. If a patient does not have enough cartilage in the septum to support the nose, this weakened nasal tissue can

also impede breathing. We may decide to build up the nose with a cartilage graft.

#### Reanimation

As board certified facial plastic surgeons, we can create an optimal plan to improve facial symmetry and restore facial animation. Which may include one or any combination of procedures, as facial paralysis can cause problems of the eyebrow, eyelid, cheek muscles, and mouth. A brow lift or blepharoplasty (eyelid surgery) can address sagging skin. Implants may be used to fill a depression where muscle tissue has atrophied or been removed. A muscle transfer can improve mobilization and nerve stimulus to the mouth.

#### **Scar Reconstruction**

The various surgical techniques for scar revision are designed to make the scar as smooth and invisible as possible. This can involve recreating the incision, moving skin around, or even moving the scar to make it less

noticeable. A skin flap or skin graft may be used when the main concern is improved function, rather than appearance. We will evaluate what technique to





use based on the type and location of the scar.

### **Trauma Reconstruction**

Facial trauma repair addresses correction of facial fractures or facial lacerations, commonly suffered during motor vehicle accidents, fights, domestic violence, athletic events, animal bites, etc. Traumatic facial fractures frequently involve the jawbone, cheekbone, the eye socket, or the brow and require realignment of the bone segments and fixation for proper healing. Traumatic facial lacerations can cause scarring, facial nerve damage, salivary duct transection, tear duct injury, or even loss of a body part (e.g., ear). The extent of surgeries to repair the face depends on the degree of injury.

### Fat Transfer Procedures Are the Latest Trend

Adding fat transfer to another facial plastic surgery procedure can dramatically improve results.

The latest trend in Cosmetic and Plastic Surgery is performing fat and stem cell transfer simultaneously with facelift and eyelid surgery. We have realized over the last 20-30 years that aging involves a loss of skin elasticity and strength (i.e. breaking down of collagen, elastin, and hyaluronic acid) and a general deflation and loss of volume in the face.

Aging is a subtle process that occurs daily. As we lose bone mass and density, muscle, and fat, our faces begin to show what is occurring internally. It is difficult to pin point exactly what makes us look older, but it's easy to assume wrinkles, lines, and sagging skin as the reason. Thus, for the first sixty years of Plastic Surgery, surgeons addressed this issue with facelift and neck lift surgery alone.

For a few rare individuals, with the correct bone structure and fullness, this was enough to improve their appearance to the desired point. Unfortunately for most patients, this approach was not enough to fully deliver the restored and youthful

appearance they wanted. It was not until we discovered that stem cell and fat transfer can restore volume to the face and tissues, that we finally took the next step to adequately achieve a more youthful, refreshed appearance.

Over the past three years, Dr. Jacqueline and I have been performing fat and stem cell transfer from the body to the face with simultaneous facelift and eyelid surgery. The results have been remarkable. The volume lost in the temples, eye area, jawline, and cheeks is replenished by the stem cell and fat transfer which ultimately creates smooth contours. We often liken this transformation to a balloon that begins to deflate over time and is refreshed by more air.

### Why have a fat and stem cell transfer versus a dermal filler at the time of surgery?

Fat and stem cells are your own cells, and there is very little risk of rejection of your own cells. Within 6 months of your procedure, we will know if your body is nourishing and allowing the fat/stem cells to thrive in their new location. The portion of fat and stem cells that survive will provide permanent filling and volumization to their new location! That is why we like to perform fat and stem cell transfer, rather than temporary dermal fillers, with facelift, neck lift, and eyelid surgery.

### What is the actual fat transfer process?

The process of fat transfer is an artful and time-intensive procedure. Fat is carefully harvested from a donor site on the body (inner or outer thighs, abdomen, or inner knees) that has excess and pinchable fat. The cells are then centrifuged to separate the living fat cells, stem cells, growth factors, and waste products. Stem cells are the most valuable cells obtained because they can further differentiate into muscle, bone, or muscle cells depending on the environment in which they are placed. Because stem cells are so versatile, we place these cells into lips and other areas around the mouth. In some instances, the stem cells can be injected into multiple layers of the lower eyelid. The other living fat cells are injected into different additional layers of tissue in the temples and cheeks. Typi-

cally, there is some swelling, but very little bruising from fat transfer. This process usually takes two hours to complete. A facelift, necklift, or eyelid surgery can be performed immediately following the fat transfer.

#### How long is the typical recovery period?

Plan on taking ten days to two weeks away from work. Although you won't be completely recovered after this time period, you will be able



to use make-up and feel comfortable meeting friends and even coworkers.

### Can intensive postsurgical care speed recovery time?

Nearly all my surgical patients utilize a postsurgical care service independently provided by a member of our Medical Assisting team. Depending on the patient's needs, the Medical Assistant can take the patient home or to a hotel following surgery and care for him or her overnight. The Medical Assistant can bring the patient back to our office the next day for hair washing and a thorough review of postsurgical instructions. We have noticed much faster healing, with less postsurgical bruising and swelling when patients utilize a postsurgical care service. Our patients love the convenience and decreased stress of the postsurgical healing period on family and friends.
